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Pera – Snood with bow

Pera is a classic and decorative snood. It has a sweet and open pattern with bubbles and is a fun and easy way to style your hair.

Size: Onesize Finished work measures: Approx. 12 " x 12" / 30x30 cm (slightly stretched)

Needles: 8 mm / UK 0 / US 11

Crochet hook $:2^{1\!\!/_2}\!\!-\!3$ mm /UK C / US 2

Materials: Approx. 1 oz. / 30 grams of Mercerized Cotton 8/4 (or any yarn you like with same thickness).

Round elastic (approx. 15" / 40 cm)

Approx. 1 yd of 1" / 2,5 cm wide satin ribbon for the bow

Abbreviations:

st/sts – stitch/stitches k– knit p – purl dc – double crotchet

PATTERN

Cast on 42 sts.

 row: Knit
row: k1, *(k1,p1,k1) all in same st, p3tog. Rep. from *to last st, k1
row: Purl
row: k1, *p3tog, (k1,p1,k1) all in same st. Rep. from * to last st, k1
row: Purl

The last 4 rows form the pattern, and are repeated until the work measures 12 " / 30 cm (or suitable length).

Cast off, but do not break off the yarn.

MAKE-UP

Holding the elastic against the knitting, work dc over it into the edge of knitting.

Work round three sides, leaving the cast-off edge plain.

Draw up the elastic to a suitable length and sew neatly to beginning and end of dc.

Cut the satin ribbon in two and sew one end neatly to the snood in the sides (where the elastic ends).
